## Trump's Tariff War: A Bold Move or a Costly Gamble?

Back in 2018, President Donald Trump commenced what became known as a full-blown tariff war—mostly aimed at China, but it rippled across the global economy. His goal? To bring jobs back home, protect American industries, and push back against what he called years of "unfair trade." The plan was to slap tariffs (basically taxes) on imported goods, making them more expensive and encouraging companies to buy American instead.

Some people saw it as a much-needed wake-up call. For years, they argued, countries like China had gotten away with things like stealing U.S. technology, limiting access to their markets, and undercutting American workers. Trump's tariffs, they believed, were a way to finally take a stand. And in some cases, they did give a boost to U.S. industries like steel and aluminum, at least in the short term.

But the flip side wasn't small. A lot of American businesses depend on imported parts and materials—especially from China—and suddenly those got a lot more expensive. Many companies had to raise their prices or cut costs elsewhere. Farmers took a big hit too, when China responded with tariffs of its own and stopped buying key U.S. crops. The government ended up spending billions to help farmers stay afloat.

The strategy also didn't lead to a huge wave of jobs coming back to the U.S. Some companies moved operations—but often just to other countries like Vietnam or Mexico, not necessarily home.

Still, the tariff war did spark a real conversation. It forced the world—and especially Americans—to think harder about where our stuff comes from, how global trade works, and what fairness really looks like.

One thing's clear: it changed the way America talks about trade—and that's not a small thing.

उस नटनी को देखकर मुझे अपने विद्यार्थी जीवन का स्मरण हुआ। वास्तव में हमारा जीवन भी कुछ-कुछ उस रस्सी पर चलती नटनी जैसा ही होता है। विद्यार्थियों के सामने अनेक उत्तरदायित्व होते हैं – पाठ्यक्रम को समय पर पूर्ण करना, परियोजना कार्यों को निपटाना, पारिवारिक एवं सामाजिक आयोजनों में भाग लेना, खेलकूद, मित्रों से मेलजोल, और सबसे महत्वपूर्ण – अपने जीवन के लक्ष्य को पहचानकर उसकी दिशा में सतत प्रयास करना।
